Lockers and Locks

- *All students will be assigned a school-issued three-digit combination lock. Lockers must **be always locked**. Students are responsible for personal belongings, including electronics.*

ETS Arc Cards

Mobile Phone Policy

“Door to Door” Policy: Phones must be powered off and stored in lockers from arrival until dismissal.

Chromebooks

- *Students are encouraged to bring their own Chromebook/laptop to school with them each day.*
- *New - iPads are not permitted for day-to-day classroom use. Students can access school Chromebooks instead.*
